### CE REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION RENEWAL - 2019

**FULL REGISTRANTS MUST OBTAIN 60 HRS OF CE OVER EVERY 2 YR CYCLE; AND MUST REPORT CME ANNUALLY**

**Jan. 1, 2017 - Dec. 31, 2018 is a closed 2 year CE cycle; excess credits earned in 2017 may be claimed in 2018.  
(Excess credits earned in 2018 may not be claimed in 2019 as Jan. 1, 2019 - Dec. 31, 2020 is a new cycle.)**

No limit; must be relevant to podiatry; approved by ACPME, CCPME, or Manpro at discretion of Reg. Committee. Only category with required <u>minimum</u> number of hours. On-line viewing/video participation is acceptable.			
B)	<b>Publication of Original Scientific Paper or Lecture Presenter</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>20</b>
Original paper published in a professional journal or magazine (Industry newsletters are not acceptable), OR lecture presenter at formal conference (podiatrists/ medical staff/ nurse practitioners/ nurses). Includes original posters at any accredited conference. MUST provide proof of published paper or lecture presentation.			
C)	<b>Board Certification</b> : (must provide proof of passing Board exam) ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>10</b>	<b>20</b>
D)	<b>On-line Formal Lectures or On-line formal courses</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>15</b>	<b>30</b>
Must provide certification of attendance/completion and any evaluative component results.			
E)	<b>Inter-disciplinary Setting</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>5</b>	<b>10</b>
1. Student or resident teaching/supervising.      2. Formal grand rounds: radiology, M&M etc.      3. Journal Club 4. 'Lunch time' lectures to/from health practitioners including MDs, RNs, LPNs, Physios, Chiropr's, NDs (1 CME/session)			
F)	<b>Public Education</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>6</b>
1. Lectures to public groups.    2. Screenings (incl. BCPMA volunteer opportunities).    3. Running clinics or sporting events.			
G)	<b>Industry Sponsored Lectures</b> : (1 CE per session) ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>6</b>
H)	<b>In-Office Medical Equipment Training</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>4</b>

I)	<b>Journal Reading</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>5</b>	<b>10</b>
Provide cite: name of journal & article; copy of table of contents is acceptable.			
J)	<b>CPR</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>6</b>
Required every 3 years. On-line / internet courses accepted. Annual or biennial courses accepted.			
K)	<b>CPodSBC Modules</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>3</b>	<b>6</b>

L)	<b>CPodSBC AGM Attendance</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>2</b>	<b>4</b>
M)	<b>CPodSBC Committees</b> : (IC & QAC; 2 CE per meeting) ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>12</b>	<b>24</b>
N)	<b>Cultural Sensitivity Training</b> : ..... <b>Maximum:</b>	<b>16</b>	<b>16</b>
