“Eligible and Ineligible CME topics for re-licensure”

Eligible Topics

- Clinical topics surrounding podiatric medicine and surgery
- Therapeutic topics surrounding podiatric medicine and surgery
- Topics that increase a practitioner’s technique or skill in podiatric medicine and or surgery
- Practice management topics must show an emphasis on patient satisfaction, generalized patient well-being, patient flow or quality assurance
- Programs that aim to improve computer skills as applied to learning, access to information, or electronic medical record program education
- Programs designed to increase practitioners’ skills in hospital administration, medical organizations or other health care systems
- Topics on alternative health practices designed to increase practitioners’ awareness of these techniques and how they might affect patients
- Topics designed to increase physician knowledge of billing in a practice setting
- Topics focusing on increasing health care provider resiliency and preventing burnout

Ineligible topics. Such topics include but are not limited to the following:

- Topics that are outside the scope of practice of podiatric medicine or surgery
- Wealth management or business management topics that focus on practitioner benefits i.e. financial planning
- Topics on alternative health practices that are designed to teach associated techniques
- Topics that focus on personal well-being (e.g. yoga), self-growth, or the personal development of practitioners
